 **Casa Mariol Negre 2013, Catalunya (Spain) 12.5% abv** £19.75

Macabeu, Garnatxa Blanc: Light, bright, and zesty dry white that is a great all-rounder
+ by Glass (175ml) at £5.90

Broadbent Vinho Verde NV 2013, Vinho Verde (Portugal) 9% abv £22.50

Loureiro, Trajadura, Pedema: An almost forgotten classic, brought to you by the son of the great wine writer Michael Broadbent. Refreshing, light and lively with a wonderful spritz. Very more-ish and at only 9% it can afford to be!

Bernard Maillard Muscadet 2014, Loire (France) 12% abv £24.50

Melon de Bourgogne: Another white from a less fashionable area, and thus fantastic value. Crisp, dry, and citrusy with just enough body. Perfect with seafood, salads, etc

 **Barone Fini Pinot Grigio DOC 2015, Valdadige (Italy) 12.5% abv** £27.50

A delicious Pinot Grigio with a touch more body than most, good fruit concentration, nice freshness and a delightfully soft and rounded finish

Pares Balta "Honeymoon" 2015, Penedes (Spain) 11.5% abv £28.50

Parellada: Luscious, aromatic, delicate off-dry white. Perfect with spicy dishes, and for those who don't like their wine too dry. An absolute delight and organic

Harwood Hall Sauvignon Blanc 2010, Marlborough (New Zealand) 13.5% abv . . . £30.50

Lovely combination of fleshy, tropical-fruit flavours and zingy herbaceousness, with a long and dry finish

Anton Bauer "Gmork" 2013, Wagram (Austria) 12% abv £32.50

Gruner Veltliner: A wonderfully versatile crisp, dry, food wine. This balanced Grüner Veltliner, in a spicy mid-weight style, is a marvellous match for a very broad range of dishes

Angel Sequeiros "Evoe" Albarino 2013, Rias Baixas (Spain) 13% abv £35.00

Fabulous white from the northwestern of Spain. More body than most Albarino's, this has a fabulous texture and perfect balance. Great label too!

David Traeger "Maranoa" Verdelho 2010, Victoria (Australia) 13.5% abv £37.00

Not to be confused with Verdejo from Spain, this is Verdelho, originally from Portugal. This is an exotic, full-bodied dry white with succulent tropical fruit flavours and excellent balancing crispness!

Testut Chablis "Rive Droite" 2013, Burgundy (France) 12.5% abv £37.50

Chardonnay: Wonderfully pure, clean and fresh with thrilling purity layered with crisp and creamy touches. "Rive Droite" because it comes from the right bank of the river in Chablis where all the best vineyards are located!

Villebois Pouilly Fumé 2012, Loire (France) 12.5% abv £45.00

Sauvignon Blanc The subtle nose reveals a combination of smoky and ripe fruit flavours, and the palate is dominated by the flavours of candied pineapple, peach and mango. Very long and elegant.

Calera Central Coast Chardonnay 2013, California (USA) 14.3% abv £47.50

Beautiful ripe peach, star fruit and pink rose notes waft from this smooth and flavourful Californian white. Tropical fruits, honey crisp apple, nectarine, honeydew melon and hints of sweet oak accent the soft, velvety texture and continue through a delicious, lingering around and bright finish.

★ **Egon Muller "Kanta" Riesling 2009. Adelaide Hills (Australia) 13.5% abv** £47.00

This is Egon Muller's Australian venture! Here he has crafted an exceptional wine with exquisite minerality, poached apples with lemon and honey, and a fabulously long and balanced finish.

Red Wines

🍷 **Casa Mariol Negre 2013, Catalunya (Spain) 12.5% abv** £19.75

Garnatxa, Tempranillo, Carinyena: Soft red fruits, easy tannins, and a pleasure to drink.

Domaine du Peras Merlot 2013, VdP d'Oc (France) 12.5% abv £22.50

Jammy fruit is tempered by a lovely blackcurrant-leaf note. Medium-bodied gem.

Pares Balta "Mas Petit" 2014, Penedes (Spain) 14% abv £24.50

Cabernet Sauvignon, Garnatxa: Inviting aromas of ripe raspberry and cherry are followed by a round, fruit-forward palate offering smooth tannins and balanced acidity. Aged for 7 months in used French oak barrels. Organic.

Alves de Sousa "Caldas" 2012, Douro (Portugal) 13.5% abv £27.50

Touriga Nacional, Tinto Roriz, Sousao: Absolutely bursting with warm, rich, ripe fruit supported by smooth, supple tannins. Alves de Sousa is the only Portuguese winery to be named Producer of the Year twice.

D. Los Santos Crianza 2010, Rioja (Spain) 13.5% abv £29.50

Tempranillo: Aged for 14 months in American and French oak barrels, it is full of lively forest fruit on the palate, with chocolate and elegant spices.

Haut Musiel Lirac 2009, Rhône (France) 13.5% abv £30.50

Rich and juicy, grippy yet fresh, this red has plenty of character and a concentrated texture which is fleshy and gently spicy.

Vins d'Orrance "Simply Red" 2014, Coastal Region (South Africa) 14% abv £31.50

Shiraz, Mourvedre, Cinsault, Viognier: A smooth, sexy red with soft tannins, flavours of blackcurrant and strawberries, layered with spices.

Pannunzio "GV" Malbec 2014, Mendoza (Argentina) 14% abv £34.50

Vibrant and currant fruit with lush smoky edges and spicy too; attractive concentration and depth of fruit vs a touch of tannin grip and oomph.

Cloof Pinotage 2008, Darling (South Africa) 14% abv £38.50

Full bodied with a delicious savoury tone, flavours of plum and damson leading to a slightly smoky finish with hints of dark chocolate.

David Traeger "Three Centuries" 2009, Victoria (Australia) 13.6% abv £45.00

Shiraz: Classic, elegant Heathcote Shiraz with fine structure, juicy red and black fruit, and leathery complexity. Delicious.

Harwood Hall Pinot Noir 2012, Central Otago (New Zealand) 13.5% abv £47.50

Combines lovely lifted red cherry perfumes with funky/sappy fermentation aromas and a pure core of red fruits.

Château Edmus Grand Cru St Emilion 2007, Bordeaux (France) 13% abv £58.00

Merlot, Cabernet Franc This wine has a silky texture, jammy raspberries, liquorice, cocoa and citrus flavours. It's exquisite, medium bodied, and is drinking perfectly right now! A perfect balance of tannins and freshness.

Corvina, Corvinone, Rondinella: A wine of great concentration, nose brimming with sour cherries and forest

🍷 **Domaine du Peras Rosé 2015, VdP d'Oc (France) 12.5% abv £21.50**

Cinsault: Light, dry, strawberry-scented pink

Alain Gueneau Sancerre Rosé 2013, Loire (France) 12.5% abv £45.50

Pinot Noir: The nose offers aromas of citrus fruit and sweet red fruit, followed by lively summer berries on the palate. A class above most other rosés. Fantastic.

Sweet Wines

✿ **Kracher Cuvee Beerenauslese 2011, Burgenland (Austria) 11% abv £36.50**

Welschriesling, Chardonnay: Delicious dessert wine with aromas of peach and apricot along with drippy honey-comb and some vanilla. It has a nice creamy body with hints of apricots and pineapple and peaches. From a legendary Austrian winemaker too!

Ca' Venanzio Spumante DOC, Prosecco (Italy) 11% abv £28.50

Glera: Great value, well-made, crowd-pleasing sparkling white!

Francois Diligent "Cuvee Anastasia" NV, Champagne (France) 12% abv £66.00

Pinot Noir: Rich fruit and good lees age combine to make this a well-rounded, toasty and complex wine.

Brice Brut Rosé NV, Champagne (France) 12% abv £68.00

Pinot Noir: Lovely, summer fruit scented, dry, classy Champagne. Perfectly romantic!
